Gordon G. Chang is the preeminent expert on China. Mr. Chang has appeared on Fox Business Network, Fox News Channel, Newsmax, CNN, MSNBC, CNBC, PBS, the BBC, and Bloomberg Television. He is a regular co-host on CBS News Radio, *Eye on the World* with John Batchelor.

His writings on China and North Korea have appeared in *The New York Times*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *The National Interest*, *The American Conservative*, *Barron's*, *The Daily Beast*, *Commentary*, *National Review* and *Forbes.com*. He is a Columnist at *Newsweek*, The Hoover Institution, and writes regularly for *The Hill*. He has also authored *China Is Going to War*, *The Great U.S.-China Tech War*, and *Losing South*

Korea, all published by Encounter Books. His previous books are *Nuclear Showdown: North Korea Takes On the World* and *The Coming Collapse of China* from Random House.

Due to his expertise, he has briefed the Central Intelligence Agency, the Pentagon, the State Department, and the National Intelligence Council. Mr. Chang has also appeared before the House Committee on Foreign Affairs and the U.S.-China Economic and Security Review Commission. He has spoken at numerous universities, Washington think tanks and before industry and investor groups, such as Bloomberg, the Royal Bank of Scotland, and Credit Lyonnais Securities Asia.

Mr. Chang is a distinguished Senior Fellow at the Gatestone Institute and a member of its Advisory Board. He is also on the Advisory Board of the Global Taiwan Institute. He lived and worked in China and Hong Kong for nearly two decades. He served two terms as a Trustee of Cornell University where he received his undergraduate degree and received his J.D. from Cornell Law School.
