Tom Fitton is the President of *Judicial Watch*, the public interest group that investigates and prosecutes government corruption. He also hosts a weekly podcast. Under Fitton's leadership, *Judicial Watch* was named one of Washington's top ten most effective government watchdog organizations by *The Hill* newspaper. He has been quoted in *TIME*, *Vanity Fair*, *The Washington Post*, *The New York Times*, *The Associated Press*, *The Los Angeles Times*, and *The New York Post*. He has appeared on ABC, CBS, NBC, CNN, FOX News, and MSNBC.

Tom is a prolific writer and *New York Times* bestselling author: *The Corruption Chronicles* (2014); *Clean House* (2017), *A Republic Under Assault* (2022) and the just released, *Rights and Freedoms in Peril*, on October 15, 2024. He has also authored numerous articles, such as "Judicial Activism Hurts our Courts," "What Bill Clinton Knew About bin Laden," "Following Terrorism's Money Trail," "Every Town is a Border Town," and "Obama's Records Problem."

In 2015, Tom received the American Conservative Union's *Defender of the Constitution* Award. In November 2020, President Trump appointed him to the D.C. Commission on Judicial Disabilities and Tenure, which evaluates judges for the D.C. Superior Court. His term ends on July 29, 2025.

Prior to his work with *Judicial Watch*, Tom was a radio and television host. He was a political analyst for *America's Voice* and *National Empowerment Television*. He is a former employee of the International Policy Forum, the Leadership Institute, and Accuracy in Media. Tom holds a B.A. in English from George Washington University.
